Review Guiding Principles

- Current enrollment and future growth (new builds, developments, projections)
- The number of families impacted
- Time to and from school, maximize safety and efficiency
- Elementary and middle school feeder areas and AFUHSD boundaries
- Conclude large-scale boundary revision process with enough lead time to allow families and schools to plan and prepare (December 2018). *Additionally, to have new boundaries in place before Open Enrollment begins.*
- Socio-economic and diversity
- Max capacity (of a building), class size (and sections), schools already at capacity
- Areas who have moved recently
- Include transportation cost with scenarios
- K-8 but could some go just for middle school
- Current Open Enrollment numbers
