Guiding Principles (20 minutes to discuss and develop)

BRC will develop considerations in addition to the District consideration

- Current enrollment and future growth.
- The number of families impacted.
- Time to and from school, maximize safety and efficiency.
- Neighborhoods and communities.
- Elementary and middle school feeder areas and AFUHSD boundaries.
- Conclude large-scale boundary revision process with enough lead time to allow families and schools to plan and prepare (December 2018). *Additionally to have new boundaries in place before Open Enrolment begins.*
